JANUARY 22, 2018 REGULAR BOARD MEETING**

**A. Resolution & Proposal for USA Baseball – Fun At Bat Program**

BE IT RESOLVED: that the Trenton Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, approves the USA Baseball–Fun At Bat Program. This program will provide all Elementary physical education teachers with online access to SHAPE America which is a structured, fun and safe bat-and-ball activity curriculum. USA Baseball will be implemented in all 12 elementary schools in grades K-5 during students’ physical education class. Each teacher will receive a Franklin Sports equipment kit and a pack of ten USA Baseball Championship Principle books for the period of January 23, 2018 through June 30, 2018; no cost to the Board.

**B. Proposal Dunn Middle School 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Dance**

BE IT RESOLVED: that the Trenton Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, approves Dunn Middle School’s 8<sup>th</sup> Grade end of the year formal Dinner Dance at The Hilton Garden Inn-Hamilton Manor, Hamilton, NJ on June 15, 2018 from 5:00pm to 9:00pm; no cost to the Board.

**C. Proposal for Young Audience Performance at Franklin Elementary School**

BE IT RESOLVED: that the Trenton Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, approves Young Audience Performance at Franklin Elementary School. Young Audience Arts will conduct three performances for students in grade k-5. This will strengthen the learning through the arts and enrich the school community for January 23, 2018 through June 30, 2018; at a cost, not to exceed \$4,980.00. **D. Proposal for ACHIEVE 3000**

BE IT RESOLVED: that the Trenton Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools approves ACHIEVE 3000. This program is a literacy platform and blended learning program with differentiated solutions for ELLs for the period of January 23, 2018 through June 30, 2018; at cost, not to exceed \$16,220.00. **E. Proposal for Washington Elementary School Technology Integration Professional Learning**

BE IT RESOLVED: that the Trenton Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, approves the Washington Elementary School Technology Integration Professional Learning Program. This program will offer teachers the opportunity to strengthen their technological skills through targeted training sessions. These training sessions will ultimately support the integration of technology across the curriculum. This program will be implemented from January 23, 2018 through June 2018; at no cost to the board.

**F. Resolution to Partner with Teresa Lasala, Consultant with Positive Discipline Association**

BE IT RESOLVED: that the Trenton Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, approves the Proposal for Partnership with Teresa Lasala, consultant with Positive Discipline Association for the period of January 23, 2018 to June 30, 2018; at a cost, not to exceed \$3,940. **G. Resolution to Approve Community Partnership with Woodrow Wilson Elementary School and Mercer Council**

BE IT RESOLVED: that the Trenton Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, approves the Community Partnership with Mercer Council to assist in furthering student experience in academic and socio-emotional success. The program consists of 8 lessons that will focus on topics related to

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a positive self-esteem, decision, making, information about tobacco, advertising, dealing with stress, communication skills, and assertiveness from February 28, 2018 through June 2018; at no cost to the Board.

**H. Resolution to Approve Community Partnership with Woodrow Wilson Elementary School and East Trenton Committee**

BE IT RESOLVED: that the Trenton Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, approves the Community Partnership with East Trenton Committee to collaborate on community services for students in grades Pre-K - 5. The collaboration will consist of mentoring and sharing of resources for students and their families. February 28, 2018 through June 2018; at no cost to the Board.

**I. Resolution to Approve Community Partnership with Woodrow Wilson Elementary School and NJ Department of Health**

BE IT RESOLVED: that the Trenton Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, approves the Community Partnership with NJ Department of Health to collaborate on community services for students in grades Pre-K-5. This collaboration will consist of several assemblies by grade span that will educate students on good oral health. Students will be provided with toothbrushes, floss, etc. to further reinforce good oral hygiene. February 28, 2018 through June 2018; no cost to the Board.

**J. Resolution to Approve Community Partnership with Woodrow Wilson Elementary School and Conserve Wildlife Foundation of NJ**

BE IT RESOLVED: that the Trenton Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, approves the Community Partnership with Conserve Wildlife Foundation of NJ to collaborate on free wildlife presentations that will assist in educating students on how to preserve wild life (peregrine falcon).
