In the event that a service provider will have regular contact with students, the service provider shall provide proof that all employees, agents and representatives have received a criminal background check and provide liability insurance. The service provider shall provide the district with all necessary documentation in a timely manner, prior to the commencement of any services by which the provider has contact with students.

A. Proposal to Approve Tania's Traveling Petting Farm and Ponies - Washington Elementary School

BE IT RESOLVED: that the Trenton Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools to Approve Tania's Traveling Petting Farm and Ponies - Washington Elementary School. The program will bring live farm animals to the school. Trained staff members will discuss animal needs, habitat, feeding habits and life and growth expectancy. June 19, 2020; no cost to the Board.
