SUPERINTENDENT'S REMARKS

Superintendent Lee welcomed everyone participating in the meeting. He discussed steps taken in the District's planning process regarding the pandemic and its effect on student learning. He thanked Aramark for their assistance in printing packets of take-home lessons for students. Additionally, Google Classroom is being utilized for remote instruction. Teachers have been asked to prepare 14 additional days of instruction. Superintendent Lee stated that schools may be closed for an indefinite time period pending further directives from the Governor.

Six school sites are set up for meal distribution by Aramark. Information is on the District website. The Superintendent stated that Mercer Street Friends is also providing meals. In response to a Board Member request, Ms. Howard gave the following counts of meals distributed:

- March 16 – 52 students picked up lunches at M.L. King Jr. School; 64 students picked up breakfast and lunch at Mott School; TCHS – 45 students; and Kilmer – 32 students
- March 17 – 141 students picked up lunch and breakfast at King; 157 at Mott; TCHS – 162 students; and 94 at Kilmer
- March 18 – 652 students picked up lunch and breakfast at King; 548 students at Mott; 401 students at TCHS; and 551 students at Kilmer
- March 19 – 161 students picked up lunch and breakfast at King; 301 students at Mott; 184 students at TCHS; and 151 students at Kilmer
- As of yesterday, the numbers are: 257 students at King; 425 students at Mott; 222 students at TCHS; and 217 students at Kilmer.

As of last Friday, 7,600 students logged into Google Classroom. There are approximately 12,006 students in the District. Packets were provided for students without internet access. Attendance is taken daily. Mr. Lee thanked the Teachers and Principals for all their efforts in providing instruction. He stated that additional Chromebooks will be purchased to be provided to students. He also advised that Comcast is offering free modems and internet access for those who need it.

Mr. Lee wished to give special thanks to Chief Academic Officer Ms. Elizabeth DeJesus, Parent Coordinator Ms. Denise Kreiss and Network Administrator Mr. Dennis Morgan for all they are doing to assist with remote instruction.

The Superintendent said no decision has been made yet on Prom and Graduation, and he asked everyone to check the District website for updates.

Ms. DeJesus provided information on servicing special needs students in response to questions from Ms. Marrero-Lopez. Mr. Rolle advised that the NJ Department of Ed will be providing further guidance to Districts. Superintendent Lee advised that a report will be sent to Board Members with information on how the District is servicing special needs students.

Ms. Daniels-Lane thanked the Robbins School students for preparing to perform at the meeting, and she looked forward to seeing their performance at a future Board Meeting. She also thanked the public for their patience with the District during the process of providing remote instruction.

Ms. Weakliem reported on the Facilities Committee meeting. The District will continue to work on the projects that have been slated, in order to get the West Campus up and running for next school year. Facilities personnel are also working on getting more classes for the 9th Grade Academy. Work is continuing to ensure that everything is ready for September.

Mr. Bouie stated he was not able to participate in the Operations Committee teleconference, and he called the Board's attention to Facilities Recommendation O for emergency custodial services. He stated there is a need for 15 additional Custodians to perform disinfecting and janitorial services from April through June. Ms. Daniels-Lane said that this need for deep cleaning was discussed by the Committee. Also discussed were operational procedures, bill payments, financial reports, etc. Ms. Marrero-Lopez said a discussion was held regarding possibly procuring trailers for the 9th Grade Academy during renovations.

Ms. Daniels-Lane said the Curriculum Committee also met via teleconference and discussed agenda items. She advised that some items are being recommended for approval in the hopes that school resumes. Dual credit programming was discussed regarding how it will be implemented and how it will function. Staff travel is also being recommended in the event that school resumes. The daytime adult ESL classes are being provided by a volunteer.

President Daniels-Lane echoed the other Board comments. She stated she has received numerous phone calls from community members wishing to help during this time of school closure; i.e., serving as online tutors, providing homework help, etc.

Ms. Brossoie stated there are hotlines and resources for people struggling with Covid19 and the associated quarantines. She asked that these resources be added to the website. The Superintendent asked Ms. Brossoie to send him an email with information she would like posted. Mr. Lee also said that the reactivation of Channel 19 is progressing, and this will be another vehicle to communicate.
