**A. Proposal to Approve the Martin Luther King Elementary School Attendance Committee**

BE IT RESOLVED: that the Trenton Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools to Approve the Martin Luther King Elementary School Attendance Committee. The Attendance Committee will help plan and implement ways to increase and/or improve the overall attendance of students through regular contact with parents and providing student incentive programs. March 21, 2019 through June 30, 2019; cost not to exceed \$1,080.00; GAAP code 20-236-200-100-0009-19-82.

**B. Proposal to Approve the STEM Leads For All District Schools**

BE IT RESOLVED: that the Trenton Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools to Approve the STEM Leads for All District Schools. STEM Leads will assist in increasing teacher knowledge of state science and math standards, to use student data to intervene and strategize on how to meet students' needs based on data and improve teacher practice as measured by Danielson Framework. School year 2019-20; cost not to exceed \$34,103.52; GAAP code 20-275-200-101-0009-20-82; 11-000-221-320-0000-00-81.

**C. Proposal to Approve Trenton Central High School Class of 2019 Graduation Ceremony**

BE IT RESOLVED: that the Trenton Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools to Approve Trenton Central High School Class of 2019 Graduation Ceremony to be held at the Cure Arena in Trenton, NJ. Due to the increased size in graduation rates TCHS needs a space to facilitate the graduation ceremony. Saturday, June 22, 2019; cost not to exceed \$11,512.00; GAAP codes 15-140-100-101-0009-00-05, 15-000-240-890-0000-00-05.

**D. Proposal to Approve the Princeton Symphony Orchestra (PSO) String, Percussion, Woodwinds & Brass Ensembles**

The elementary school music teachers will select students for a one-hour assembly performance. April 1 through 30, 2019; no cost to the Board.

The programs will increase over all student academic achievement, school climate will show improvement, students will apply real world math and science concepts and learn critical thinking and team building skills. National Inventors Hall of Fame has offered 4 Club Invention STEM Programs, 5 sessions each, including paying \$300 stipend to coordinators/teachers for each program.
