PERFORMANCE OF EXCELLENCE

Following the performance by Robeson Elementary School, Mr. Durán added that Principal Addie Lane is pleased to present artwork created by students at TCHS West under the direction of their Art Teachers Mr. Thomas Montanari and Ms. Nicole Backland. Additionally, TCHS West Senior Ms. Tennisha Burrell sang *The Wind Beneath My Wings*, accompanied by her Music Teacher Mr. Eucles Moore on the trumpet.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION – AGENDA ITEMS ONLY

Mr. Dave Winogron, First Vice President of the Trenton Education Association (TEA) read the mission statement for the department of Systems, Data Management and Accountability as shown on the District website. He discussed continuing issues and problems with technology in the District.

Ms. Naomi Johnson-Lafleur, TEA President, expressed concern about the reception given to the public. She felt that the public comment portion of the meeting should not be held after the presentations, due to the length of time that presentations typically run. She also discussed the process of formulating Student Growth Objectives (SGO).

SUPERINTENDENT'S REMARKS

Mr. Durán said the TCHS Main Band and Orchestra were asked to perform for the State Commissioner of Education at the annual New Jersey School Boards Association Workshop held last week in Atlantic City. He stated the students did an amazing job and he thanked them for their hard work. He said it was an honor for Trenton to be selected to open for the Commissioner.

Additionally, Washington Elementary School hosted a performance of *In the Heights*, an award-winning Broadway show, for the Hispanic Heritage Dinner and Celebration.

The Superintendent gave an update on the lawsuit filed by the Board against the School Development Authority (SDA). He stated that many community groups, including students, have held rallies to express their concerns about the physical condition of TCHS Main. Last week, the Board's attorney, Mr. Richard Shapiro, appeared in court. The SDA asked for the suit to be dismissed, but the Judge did not grant this motion. The Judge asked the District and the SDA to meet before hearings begin in an attempt to work out some details.

Mr. Durán stated that the District is moving along quickly with the renovations at Jefferson School, with move-in anticipated for the month of November, pending the results of final inspections conducted.

Mr. Durán called the Board's attention to Finance Item P, the resolution for a scheduling plan for 2014-2015. He stated that he has had several meetings with administrators and others to address the concerns that have arisen in the current school year. There were two consultants hired for this year's scheduling – one to develop the academic framework for the schedule and one to implement the scheduling process through the technical side. The academic work was completed on time, but the technical work was not. Hence, the consultant who was hired for the technical work has not been paid. Mr. Durán thanked the school-based staff who stepped in to do some of the work that the consultant did not. He also said there were some areas where the academic framework needs to be adjusted at the high school level, and revisions will be made to the high school course catalog. Additionally, a middle school course catalog will be adopted.

BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

Mr. Truehart stated that the Board has a certain hierarchy it must follow, and the day-to-day operation of the District is left to the Superintendent and his staff. He said the Board is holding the Superintendent and his staff accountable for performing the services they were hired to provide.

Ms. Montañó introduced Student Board Member Ms. Madia Roberts, who is a senior at TCHS West. She also agreed with the Superintendent's comments regarding the students from TCHS Main who performed at the School Boards conference in Atlantic City. She stated that they were marvelous, and she asked for another round of applause to acknowledge them.

Lastly, Ms. Montañó commented about the recent and ongoing protests by the community regarding the physical condition of TCHS Main. She said the Board is very glad to see the community being involved, and the Board will continue to address this issue from a legal standpoint.

PRESENTATIONS TO THE BOARD

Mr. Durán introduced Dr. Thelma Napoleon-Smith, who facilitated a presentation on the Hedgepeth Williams Case (handout attached). The District has been engaging in a partnership with Dr. Napoleon-Smith to conduct a Hedgepeth Williams Day in recognition of the court case that occurred in Trenton and what it means for our students. The Board offered its full support and will pass a resolution at the November 11 meeting. The Superintendent stated that Reverend Armstrong from Shiloh Baptist Church had planned to present tonight but could not attend, so he wanted to express his support also.

Dr. Wesley Boykin, Executive Director for Systems, Data Management and Accountability, gave an update on technology (handout attached). Board Member comments and questions were as follows:

Parents Ilma and Olex Heredia discussed issues with violations of their children's IEPs. Board Attorney Carl Tanksley Jr. and the Board President asked the Heredias to bring their concerns to the Assistant Superintendent for Special Education. Ms. Montañó asked the Heredias to contact the Board again if their issues are not resolved by November 2.

Ms. Janice Williams, taxpayer, felt that the public had been disrespected relative to procedures for addressing the Board. She also took umbrage with comments made during the presentation on School Safety & Discipline, stating that teachers were blamed for classroom violence without data to back up this contention. She felt that this comment should have been responded to by Leadership Team.

Ms. Williams also expressed concern with the Advanced Computer Application course, stating it does not appear in the Course Catalog, has not been Board approved, and does not have any credits assigned to it. She stated that students are enrolled in this class and the teacher was stopped from teaching it at TCHS Main, while it is being taught at TCHS West. She asked if students will receive credit for this course at the end of the marking period, and she stated that she has filed a Level III Grievance on this matter.

Ms. Williams said she is glad to see the G&T program being implemented, but she reminded Administration that there is a collaborative clause in the TEA contract regarding the introduction of new programmatic offerings and the involvement of TEA in the process. She also recalled the presentation on technology and the statement that there will be key people in the buildings to address technological concerns and issues by teachers. She stated this also must be negotiated with TEA because there are no Technology Captains.

Ms. Johnson-Lafleur reminded the Board that certain items must be negotiated, such as online instruction for G&T. Regarding technology issues in the schools, she stated that the
