Whereas, a committee has been formed to explore and plan for the recognition of the historic Supreme Court decision of January 31, 1944 and what it means for the students of Trenton Public Schools; and

Whereas, the committee has decided to celebrate “Hedgepeth-Williams Day” on the last Friday in January; now therefore

Be it resolved, that the Trenton Board of Education hereby declares January 31, 2014 “Hedgepeth-Williams Day” throughout the school district.
