BE IT RESOLVED: that the Trenton Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, approves the Math District Wide Professional Development Workshop for K-1 teachers supporting students' place value understanding with an emphasis on fluency with ten-structured addition/subtraction solution methods on February 2, 2018; cost not to exceed \$1,275.00.
