After receiving degrees from the Florida School of the Arts and The Acting Studio of New York City, Joe went on to land regular spots on The Cosby Show, Guiding Light and Law & Order. Joe, a native of Trenton, NJ has spent the last few years as an independent film producer and a documentarian with a particular emphasis on high-risk teenagers, community relationships with law enforcement and educating local students on all facets of the film making business.

The “Let’s Film” program is an independent film making course that has been funded by local grants and is completely **FREE** to all participants. Eligible students should currently be attending a Trenton or Hamilton High School and have an interest in film making, acting, writing, producing or directing. Students will learn all aspects of film making from start to finish and no experience is needed. The program will be conducted once a week for 2 hours. Current sessions are completely virtual but in person sessions will resume when allowed at our new Hamilton, NJ location.
