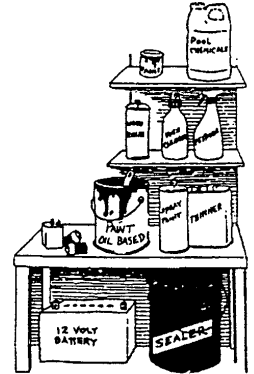

Aerosol Cans	Mercury
Photographic Chemicals	Used Oil Filters
Used Motor Oil	Paint Thinner
Lighter Fluid	Oil Based Paint
Propane Gas Tanks	Stains/Varnishes
Pesticides/Herbicides	Anti-Freeze
Pool Chemicals	Driveway Sealer
Florescent Bulbs/CFL's	Gasoline
Incandescent/Compact Energy	Gas/Oil Mix
Saving Light Bulbs	Insect Repellants
ALL BULBS MUST BE BOXED AND TIGHTLY SEALED	Car Batteries

Disposal Procedures for Latex Paint:

- 1. Latex paint must be dried out by absorbent*
- 2. Place sand, kitty litter or speedy dry into paint. (Absorbent)*
- 3. Once Paint is absorbed, place lid back on paint can*
- 4. Place paint can in plastic bag.*
- 5. Place plastic bag out for regular trash collection*
