The City of Trenton Health Department and TPS have partnered to provide access to the vaccine, guided by the appropriate guidelines, and targeted to accelerate access to frontline staff who support the Trenton Community. Any current employee of the Trenton Public Schools and the Early Childhood Provider network who wishes to participate in this vaccination rollout plan should complete the registration form.

The City's Health Department will administer the Johnson and Johnson vaccine at the TCHS Main Campus Johnson and Johnson vaccine on Wednesday, 3/31/2021, and Thursday, 4/1/2021, between the hours of 3 pm - 7 pm. Completion of this form is optional as vaccinations are not mandatory. Every effort will be made to provide vaccines to all interested parties. Access to the Johnson and Johnson vaccine is limited by supply. The deadline for this form is Friday, 3/26/2021, by 5 pm. The first 100 respondents will be notified to receive the vaccine on Wednesday, and the second half will be notified to go on Thursday. There are 200 slots available. We will create a waiting list for further vaccine opportunities.
